

East Fortune Aeromodellers

East Fortune Aeromodellers (EFA) has a membership ranging widely in age and expertise from beginners to competition flyers. We fly fixed-wing and helicopter models of all kinds – including scale, aerobatic, sport, jets and gliders, and, in the winter, indoor electric models at a local sports hall. Other activities include several barbeques and fly-ins through the year and a periodical newsletter for members.

Flying Sites - We operate from two outstanding sites, the original one is on the old East Fortune Airfield and has a long tarmac runway, particularly good for jets, and the other is at Mount Lothian to the south east of Edinburgh near Penicuik. The **East Fortune** site consists of a section of the tarmac perimeter track, surrounded by 5 acres of grass, and has a large Club Hut with a viewing window facing the runway. Members can fly here throughout the week but the most popular times are Wednesday afternoons/evenings when teaching takes priority and Saturdays. While the Sunday Market is operating, flying is limited to helicopters and small electric fixed-wing models. Flying is also limited on some weekends when the track is being used for motor cycle racing. Members then use our other site at **Mount Lothian** which is available for flying at all times throughout the year. This site has a good, wide, grass runway, and is very convenient for Edinburgh members (about 15-20 min from the bypass). It is particularly popular with glider flyers on summer evenings.

Training for Beginners – We offer training to members who are new to the hobby using the ‘buddy box’ (dual control) technique. This takes new flyers up to the stage where they are competent and confident enough to fly on their own and to achieve the Scottish Aeromodellers Association (SAA) Bronze Safety Certificate. All SAA affiliated clubs require this certificate before people can fly unsupervised. Most training is done at East Fortune on Wednesday evenings during the summer but can be done at other times by arrangement. Advice is also available to new members on selecting a first model, and on trimming and checking it for flight.

Visitors – You are welcome to come to either flying field to see some flying and to have a trial flight (dual control) on one of the Club training models. It is best to contact either the Chairman or Secretary (see below) beforehand to organise a convenient time, and, in the case of East Fortune, so that someone can meet you at the entry gate to the site which is kept locked. Visitors who are qualified to fly solo must show evidence of insurance before flying.
